The ALMR Workshop is the annual meeting of the Australian Society of Labour Economists. The meeting is supported by Jobs and Skills Australia, the Australian Bureau of Statistics and the Department of Employment and Workplace Relations. The purpose of the meeting is to disseminate high quality research in labour economics and labour relations and to promote informed public debate about current labour market issues.

Participants and discussants will include senior academic economists and labour economists in the public and private sectors. Early career researchers, including PhD students close to completing, are particularly encouraged to submit papers. Any theoretical, applied or policy related papers on any aspect of the labour market are welcome.

Papers, which need only to be at 'working paper' stage, will be selected on the basis of their quality and in relation to their general interest. Preference will be given to papers on the following themes:

- 1) Employment, education, training and skills shortages
- 2) Labour markets and demographic changes
- 3) New ways work is organised
- 4) Gender equity
- 5) Contemporary labour market issues
- 6) Applied labour econometrics
- 7) Work, welfare and the disadvantaged
